Interprofessional Continuing Education Course"Review of Current Periodontal Disease Topics"

Presenter: LCDR Stefano Palazzolo, DDS, MS Course Description:

This course provides a review of periodontal diseases, the immune response, and both surgical and non-surgical interventions. Staging and Grading will be discussed and the importance of the Clinical Attachment Level (CAL). The role of the dental hygienist as a periodontal co-therapist will be emphasized.

Course Objectives:

- 1. Describe treatment guidelines for a variety of periodontal patients including but not limited to periodontal emergencies, nonsurgical therapy, and dentin hypersensitivity.
- 2. Explore various osseous surgical procedures, including guided tissue regeneration, and full/partial thickness flaps.
- 3. Describe the types of materials used in implants and the procedures for the placement and restoration of implants.
- 4. Apply evidence-based protocols to identify periodontal therapies that will reduce the bacterial load and those that modulate the host response.
- 5. Identify periodontal risk factors that are acquired, environmental, and genetic.


Speaker's Profesional Biography:

LCDR Stefano Palazzolo attended New York University College of Dentistry (DDS, 2015) and then completed a highly competitive one-year General Practice Residency (GPR) at Naval Medical Center San Diego. From 2018-2021, LCDR Palazzolo attended the Naval Postgraduate Dental School in Bethesda, MD for advanced residency training in Periodontics. In May 2022 he achieved board certification to become a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology. LCDR Stefano Palazzolo is currently serving as the Periodontist of NMRTU Groton, CT since July 2021.
